Re: NOP- COR, Clarifications of the US- Canada Organic Equivalency Arrangement

Genesis seeds is an organic processor inspected and certified in compliance to COR standard by Agrior Ltd. Its produce is in compliance with the terms of the US-Canada Organic equivalence arrangement.

On June 17, 2009 the Department of Agriculture (USDA) and the Canadian Food Inspection Agency (CFIA) exchanged letters confirming the equivalency of the two countries' organic programs. The Equivalency determination can be viewed at the link below.

The Arrangement covers the accreditation system of both regulations entirely meaning that agricultural products certified in accordance with the terms of the US- Canada Organic Equivalency Arrangement **are eligible for sale as organic in both countries**. The product being traded under this arrangement does not have to originate within either country.

The arrangement only applies to those Certification Bodies who are accredited directly by either authority. **Agrior Ltd. is accredited directly by the CFIA to COR standard** please see it in the link: <http://www.inspection.gc.ca/english/fssa/orgbio/cbliste.shtml>

The arrangement does not cover other country to country agreements by either party.
